


Please follow below instructions to reset and re-establish connections between 156x scanner and 3656 cradle.

**Step 1:** For 30 seconds unplug all cables from the cradle, and take battery out of the scanner.


Step 2: Plug cables and insert battery back making sure all connections are firm and unwavering.

**Step 3:** Scan below barcodes in number order <u>then</u> wait for 30 seconds. Please insure you hear the scanner beep each time you scan. When scanning keep at least 3 inches of gap between the scanner and the barcodes.




**Step 4:** Notice the blue light on the cradle flash approximately 2 times every 1 second If faster please follow **Step 3** again.

**Step 5:** Scan the two barcodes underneath the cradle starting with *Set Connection* followed by the *Serial Number*, see example below:



**Step 6:** After scanning the two barcodes you will notice a 3 beep sound indicating a successful link, also notice the Blue light on the cradle now flashing approximately 5 times in 1 second, if not, please follow **Step 3** to **Step 6** again.



**Step 8:** After scanning the barcodes, you will notice a 3 beep sound indicating a successful link, also notice the Blue light on the cradle is still flashing approximately 5 times in 1 second, if not, please follow Step 3 to Step 8 again.

Open Notepad, Microsoft Word or Excel and scan a random <u>retail</u> barcode to see it appear on the screen.

Blue light flashing ~2 times every 1 second: indicates the cradle is waiting for connection request from 156x scanner.

Blue light flashing ~5 times every 1 second: Indicates cradle is linked to scanner.
